2003

The Supreme Economic Council issued Resolution (5/23) to establish the Water and Electricity Company, for the purpose of purchasing water and electricity.



2017

Cabinet Resolution (494) was issued to expand the scope of the company's work as a major buyer of all types of water, with the right to sell it and engage in addition to dual production, and for His Excellency the Minister of Finance to provide the necessary credit support to the company to enable it to sign long-term purchase contracts in accordance with the principles contained in Cabinet Resolution (181) with agreement on corporate governance and contracted projects.

2019



The company's ownership was fully transferred to the Ministry of Finance with a capital of one hundred million Saudi riyals, and the new identity of the company was launched under the name of Saudi Water Partnership Company.

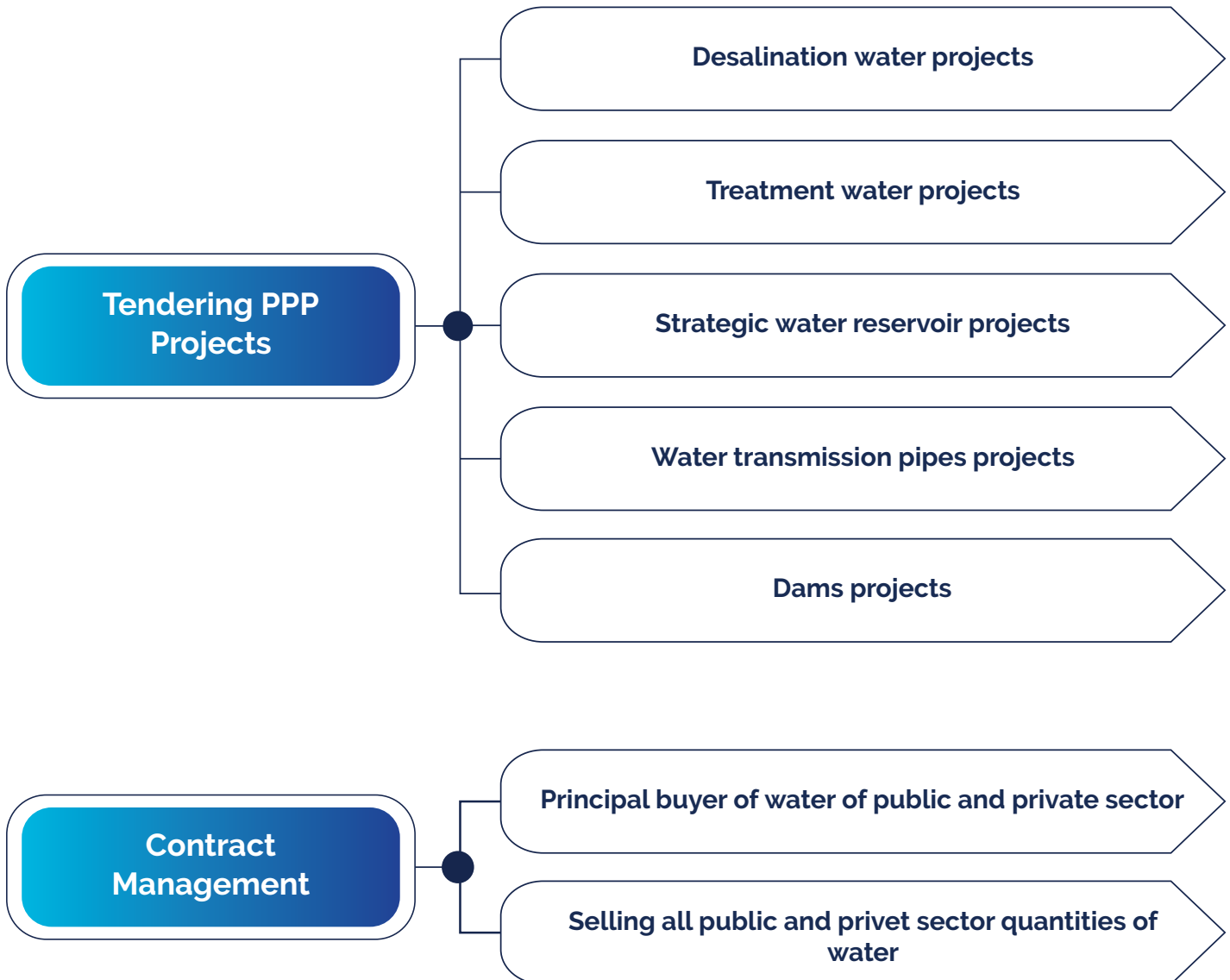

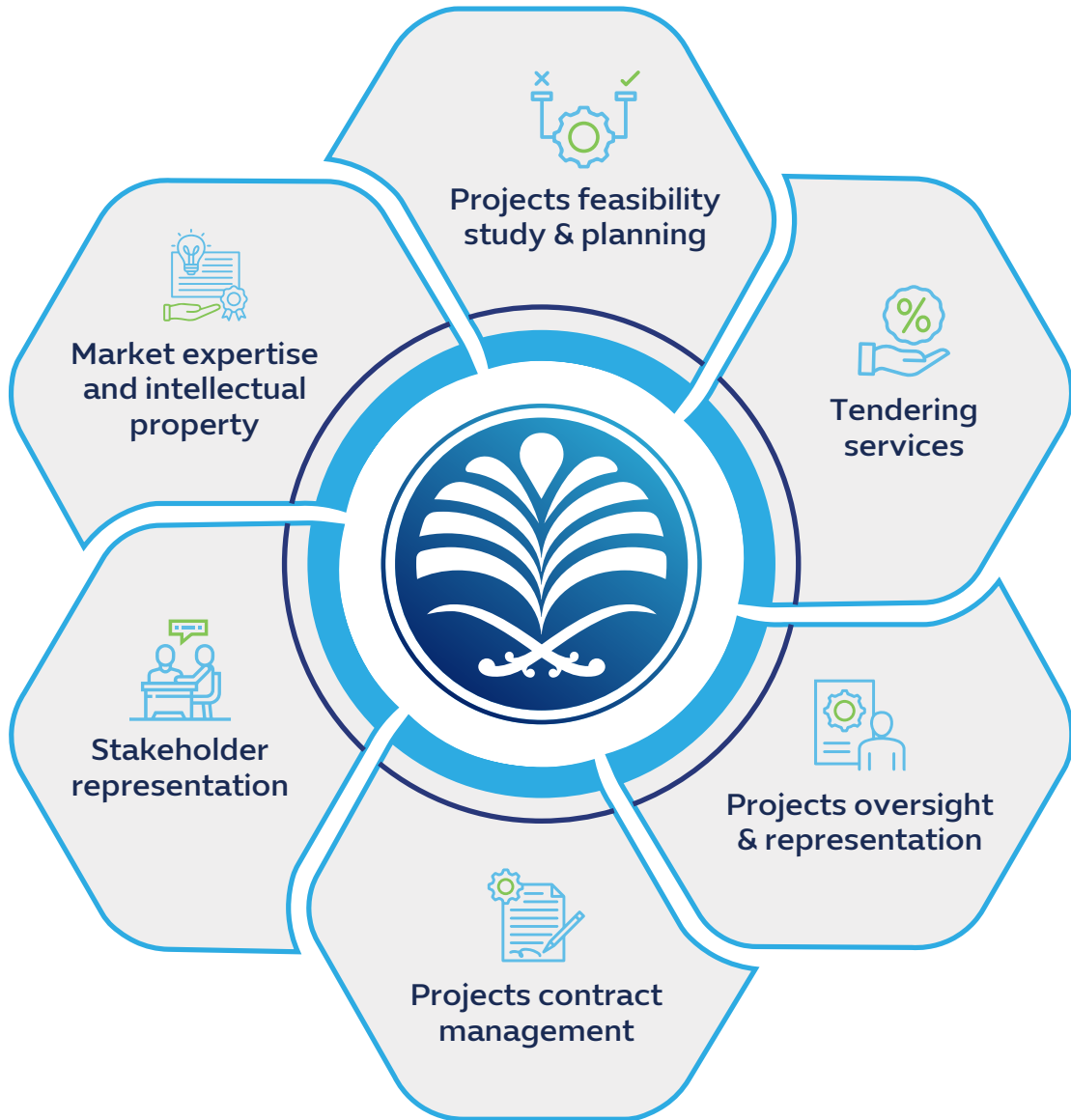

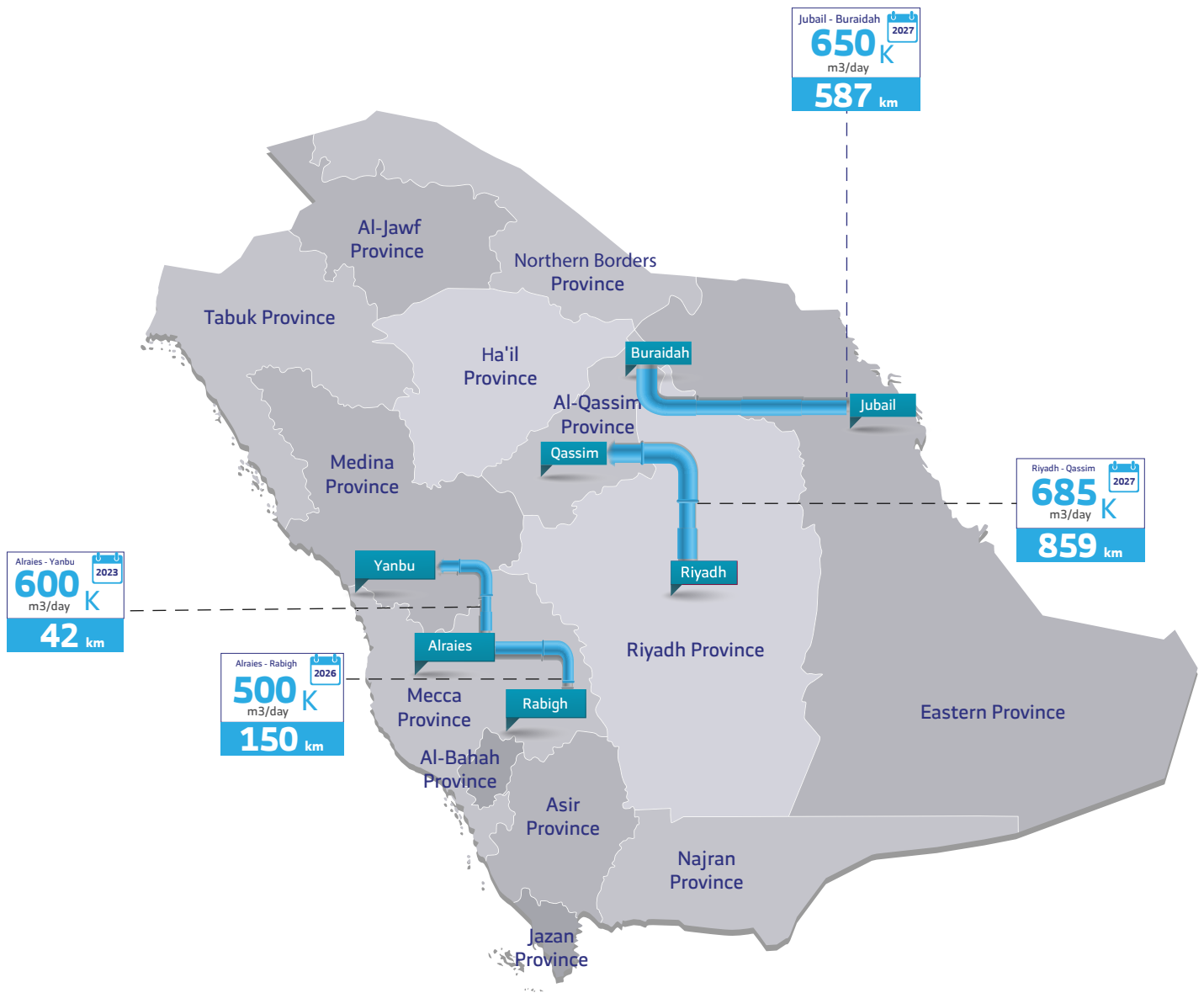

SWPC Independent Water Transmission Pipelines

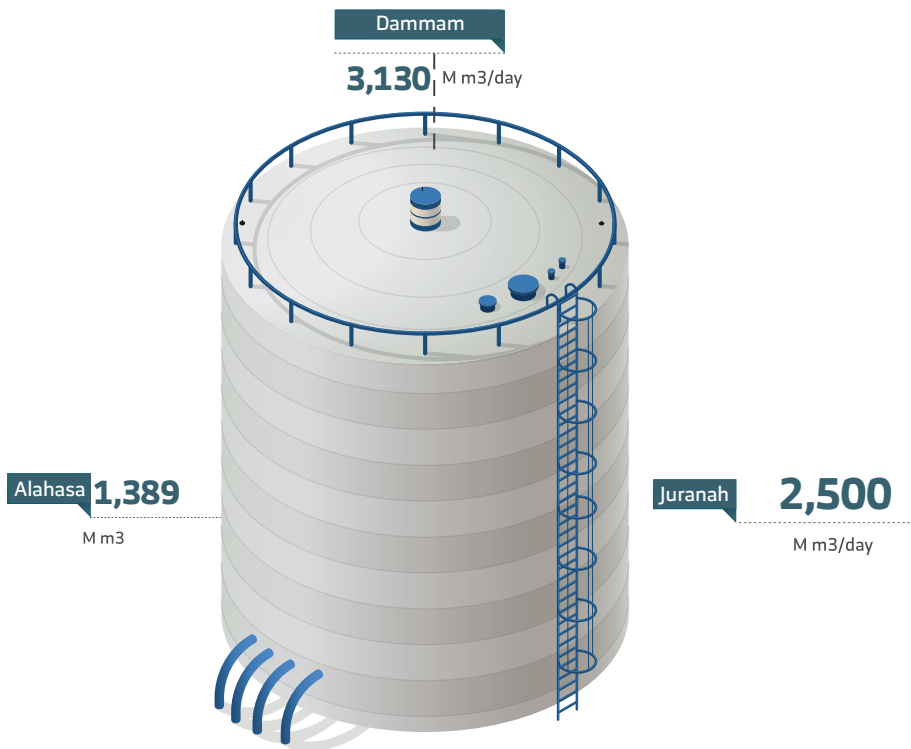


4 Desalinated Water Transmission Pipelines Projects with a capacity of **2.43 m** m³, and an estimated length of **1,638** Km.

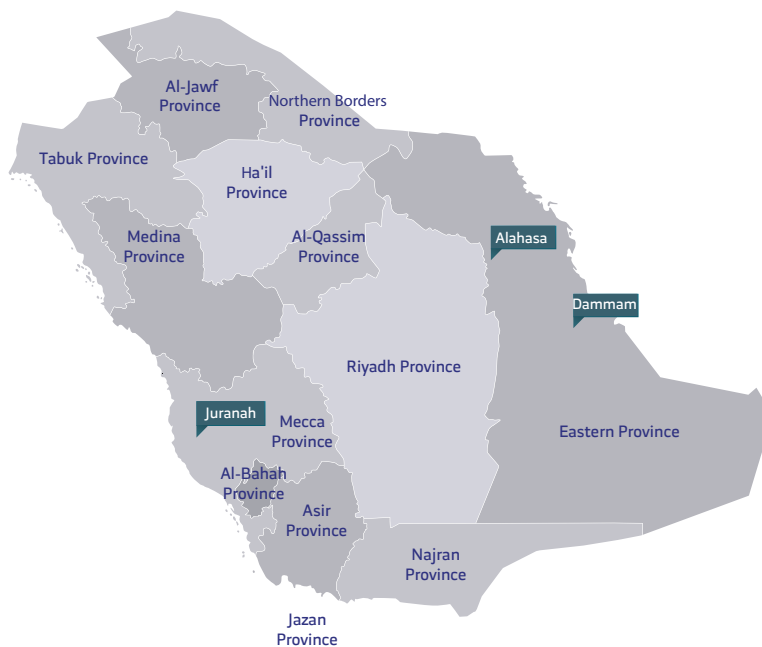

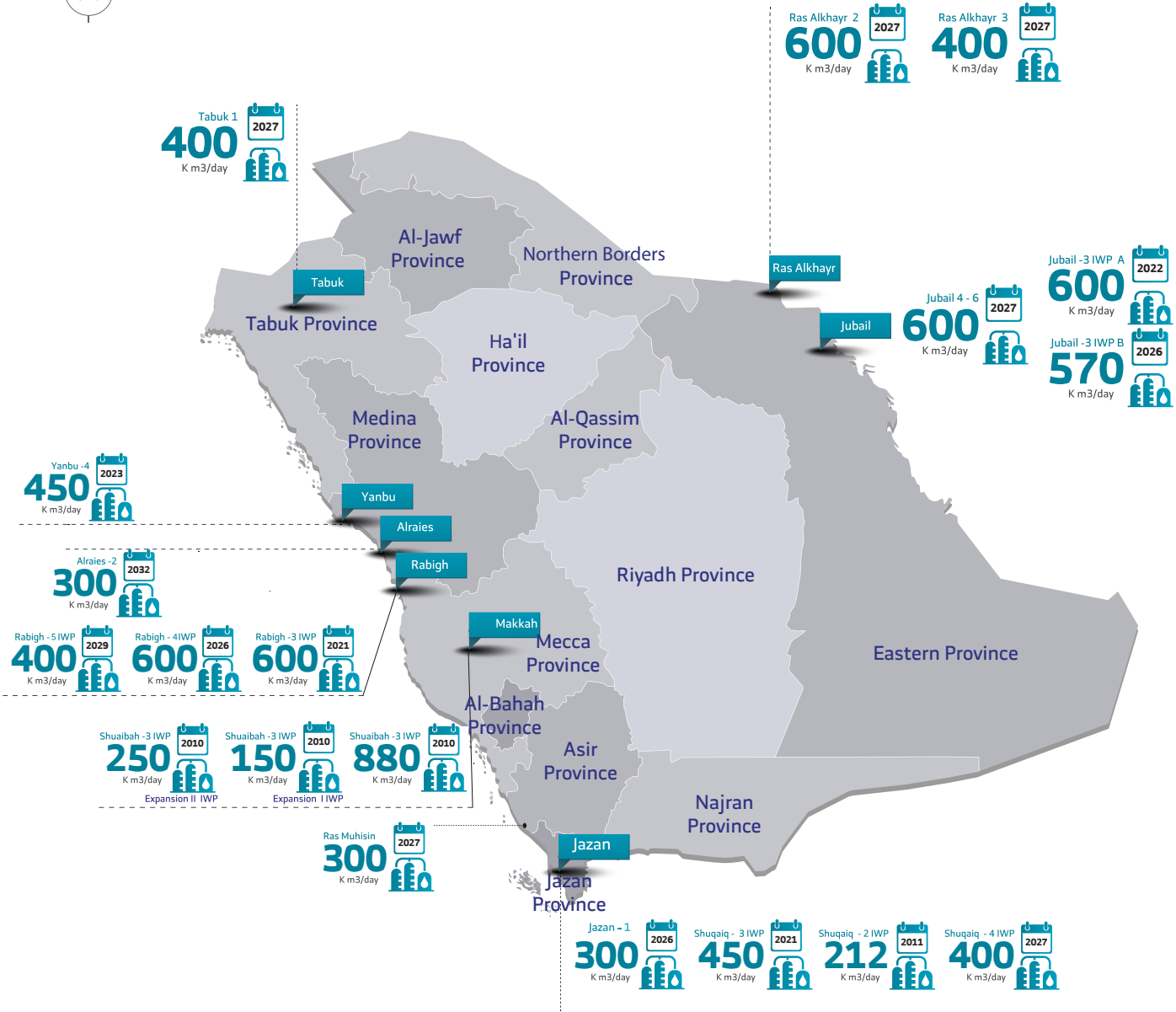
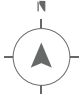
SWPC Independent Strategic Water Reservoir



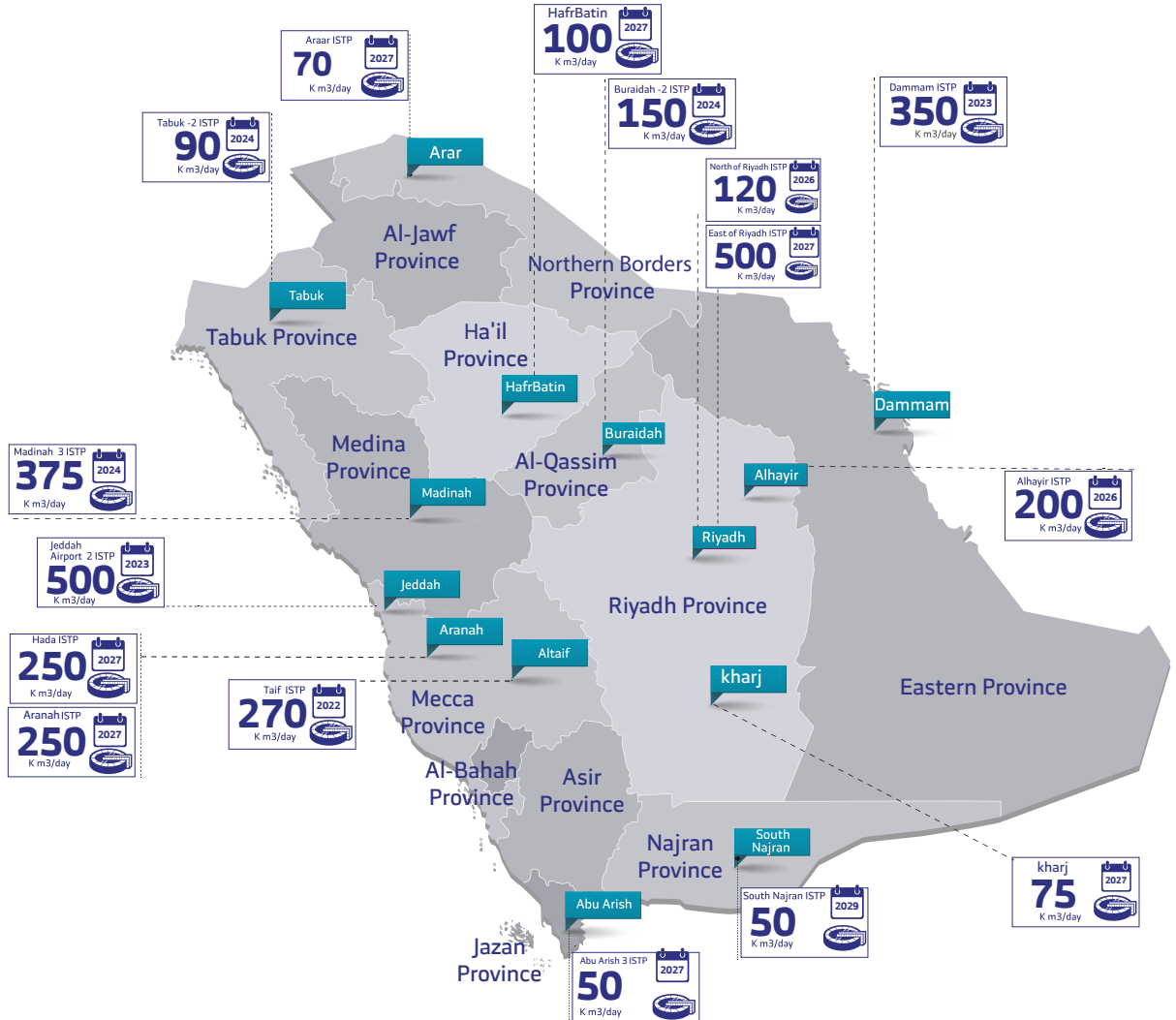
Total of Water Reservoir Plan 7,019 M m³/day

Small Scale Sewage Treatment Plant

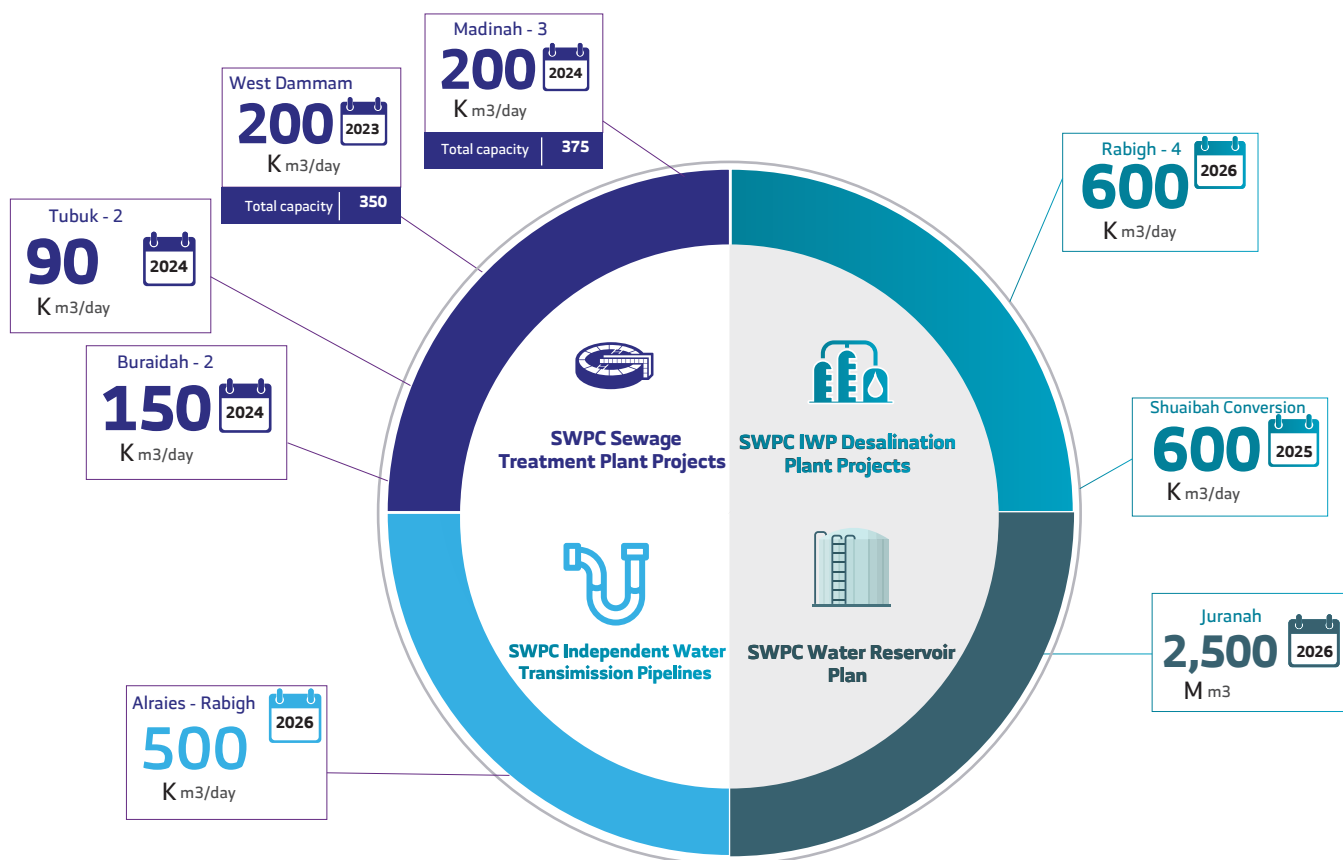
